Antelope Club Member Code of Conduct

The following will not be tolerated by the Board, Club Members, or Club Employees:

3. Intimidation
4. Physical contact with intent to harm

A member in violation of any of the four guidelines may receive a letter of reprimand, be asked to meet with the board, and/or have membership suspended or revoked. This will be dependent on how egregious the violation or if it is a repeat offense. The offending behavior can be brought to the attention of the board of directors by any member or employee of the club. *(All allegations must be accompanied by a written complaint.)*

The code of conduct will be enforced per Title II, Membership, The Club Bylaws, under Suspension/ Expulsion.

This is not a zero-tolerance policy. We want all members to enjoy the club and have a good time. It is the repeated violations of the above-mentioned guidelines that will result in a warning and may ultimately lead to expulsion.
